LPIC-3 300: Mixed Environment training covers the administration of Linux systems enterprise-wide in a mixed environment.

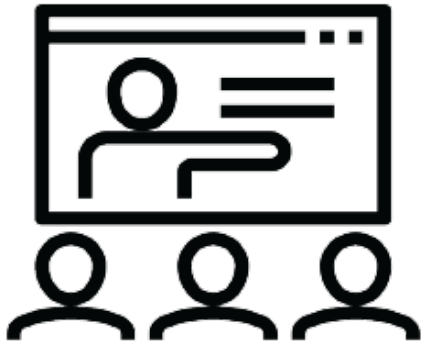

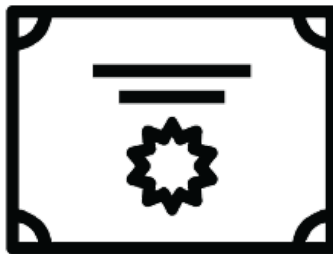
